


MAY FEATURED ART MEMBER'S CHALLENGE

Artists are invited to enter their original artwork in a juried competition at City Lights Art Gallery, 3 E. Army Street, Henderson NV 89015
Photography intake is June 2nd & 3rd from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.
June 10th Reception at 1:00 p.m. & Awards Ceremony starting at 1:30 p.m.
Accepted entries will be on exhibit in the gallery from June 7th – June 29th
Cash and ribbons will be awarded

Prizes awarded in Four categories for the Photography Show at City Lights Art Gallery:

- a. **Theme Category- Creative Challenge**: The photo must visibly contain 6 of the 10 listed items to be considered for judging. The items are: Cloth fabric, metal, glass, wood, sand, paper, rock, natural vegetation, liquid, and/or food. Have fun and be creative with this category!
- b. Classic: Minimal manipulation of your original and organic photograph format.
- c. **Enhanced/Digital:** Modify your original photograph in an artistic art form.
- d. **Monochrome/ Selective Color**: Subject matter includes black & white, infrared, or monochromatic shades. Allows for selective color limited to one color or object in the scene.

All entries must be original and done by the submitting artist. **No copies of work found in magazines, calendars or on the internet may be used without written permission of the artist.** City Lights Art Gallery requires a Certificate of Authenticity (CoA) for each piece of artwork submitted. All artwork must be wired and ready for hanging (no saw tooth hangers are allowed). A size limit of 600 square inches for each framed work will be strictly enforced (measured from outside edges of the artwork, not including frame- 20"x30" max). Artist may submit up to two (2) entries per category with a total of eight (8) art pieces for show. Two judges will jury, and their decisions are final.

Forms available on website (CityLightsArtGallery.org): Intake Forms (2): Artist Info & Hold Harmless plus Artist Intake Record. Certificate of Authenticity (one for each print) if you don't already have one. Instructions are also provided to assist you in preparing your artwork and how to become a member.

Entry fees may be paid online on the website at CityLightsArtGallery.org (Pay/Donate tab using entry fee for juried shows- Member or Nonmember pricing). Entry Fees are as follows (Entry fees are <u>not</u> refundable):
