## 2026 Annual June Photography Show

Artists are invited to enter their original artwork in a juried competition at City Lights Art Gallery, 3 E. Army Street, Henderson NV 89015  
Photography intake is May 31<sup>st</sup> & June 1<sup>st</sup> from 10 am to 4 pm  
June 13<sup>th</sup> Reception at 5:00 – 7:00 pm with Awards Ceremony starting at 5:30 pm  
Accepted entries will be on exhibit in the gallery from June 5<sup>th</sup> – June 27<sup>th</sup>  
Artwork pick-up will be on June 28<sup>th</sup> & June 29<sup>th</sup> from Noon to 4 pm  
Cash and ribbons will be awarded

Prizes awarded in four categories for the Photography Show at City Lights Art Gallery:

**Images may be in color, B&W or sepia in any category. Refer to Entry Guidelines for what is allowed.**

- a. **Challenge:** Create a single photograph incorporating **at least six** of the following elements: sieve/whisk/colander, glassware, box, prism or crystal ball, photograph within a photograph, water, shiny/reflective surface, flashlight, wooden cutting board, and/or fruit.
- b. **Creative:** Create an artistic transformation of your original photograph using conceptual, composite, or manipulated techniques. Images must originate from the photographer's own capture.
- c. **Landscape:** Landscape photography centers on the natural environment, capturing expansive or intimate views of land, water, and sky. It emphasizes place, light, atmosphere, and composition, with minimal or incidental human-made elements.
- d. **Architecture:** Photographs focusing on buildings or built structures as the primary subject, emphasizing design, form, materials, scale, and the relationship between structure, light, and space, in interior or exterior views.

**Entry Guidelines:** All entries must be original and done by the submitting artist. **No copies of work found in magazines, calendars or on the internet may be used. While human-controlled digital editing of your lens-based image is entirely okay, the use of automated artificial intelligence is not. Acceptable alterations are those that can be done in-camera or with photo editing software like Photoshop and/or Lightroom (or compatible programs). Images that rely heavily on AI technology or are created with AI technology will not be accepted.**

City Lights Art Gallery requires a Certificate of Authenticity for each piece of artwork submitted (form available on website). All artwork must be wired and ready for hanging (no saw tooth hangers are allowed- visit website for specific details). **A size limit of 480 square inches for each framed work will be strictly enforced (measured from outside edges of the artwork, including frame).** Artist may submit up to two (2) entries per category with a total of eight (8) art pieces for show. Two judges will jury, and their decisions are final. All artwork from the show must be picked up on June 28<sup>th</sup> or June 29<sup>th</sup> during regular gallery hours of Noon – 4 pm.


Forms available on website (CityLightsArtGallery.org)- Intake Forms (2), *Artist Info & Hold Harmless*, plus *Artist Intake Record*, and Certificate of Authenticity (one for each print) if you don't already have one. Instructions are also provided to assist you in preparing your artwork and how to become a member. The gallery reserves the right to deny any images that do not comply with the categories listed.

Entry fees may be paid online on the website at CityLightsArtGallery.org (Pay/Donate tab using entry fee for juried shows- Member or Non-Member pricing). Pricing is for cumulative entries, e.g. six entries would cost Members \$55, Non-Members \$90, etc. Entry Fees are as follows (Entry fees are not refundable):
